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*Please provide below a summary of activities and discussions and few quotes from participants:*

After all participants have been registered, the workshop started by a welcome speech addressed by Georgeta Chirleşan and the presentation of the goal of the event, agenda and brief explanations upon the materials included in the folder that participants have received. Then the project presentation followed: the objectives, target groups, partnership, activities and results have been described.

The next point was the Us&Them website presentation, with explanations and demonstration on how to access and use the online resources and modules. Participants addressed questions and expressed opinions.

After the coffee break, „O2: Curriculum and training course for Adult Educators” was followed: presentation, applicability and contexts for utilization. Participants were invited to share their impressions on the relevance and practical usability of this outcome.

„Handbook II *“One day in the shoes of ‘The other’* “ was presented in terms of structure and content, how we use it (including a practical demonstration of activity), what activities we can develop further on. Participants discussed on the various possibilities of efficiently using the manual with multicultural groups.

Then a plenary session debate was initiated, with the elements:

- Icebreaking: multicultural education
- Questions addressed to participants in order to sustain the discussions
- Closing the debate: *What exactly do you think it will (still) be important from Us&Them, in three years by now? Why?*

The workshop ended by handing over the certificates to participants and by inviting them to a complimentary meal offered by the organisers.
